Bidders shall account for all provisions pursuant to this Addendum No. 1 in submitting their bids. Each bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in their Bid in the spaces provided therein.

1. Contact Documents Revision:

- 1.1 Notice Inviting Bids, paragraph 1, page 1 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

The City of Corona, Department of Water and Power (“City”) will receive sealed bids for the **Arantine Hills Lift Station, Project No. 71590572, NIB 17-039CA** at the City of Corona Administrative Services Department, Purchasing Division Office, 400 South Vicentia Ave., Suite 320, Corona, CA 92882 no later than **April 26, 2017, 2:00 p.m.,** at which time or thereafter said bids will be opened and read aloud. Bids received after this time will be returned unopened. Bids shall be valid for 60 calendar days after the bid opening date. Bids must be submitted on the City’s Bid Forms.

- 1.2 General Conditions, Add ARTICLE 29. INSPECTOR’S FIELD OFFICE in its entirety.

ARTICLE 29. INSPECTOR’S FIELD OFFICE

- a. The Contractor shall be responsible for providing the inspector’s field office. The Office shall be a substantial waterproof construction with adequate natural light and ventilation by means of stock design

windows. Door shall have a key type lock or padlock clasp. The office shall have heating and air conditioning and shall be equipped with a telephone, a telephone answering machine, and high-speed internet service at Contractor's expense.

- b. A table satisfactory for the study of plans and two chairs shall be provided by contractor. Contractor shall provide and pay for adequate electric lights, local telephone service, and adequate heat and air conditioning for the field office until authorized removal. Additional requirements are described in Specification 01 52 13 – Field Offices.

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
