



Masters Drive Parkway Turf Replacement Project

We wish to thank those that participated in the public workshop held on February 28, 2012 and survey which ended March 13, 2012 for the **Masters Drive Parkway Turf Replacement Project**. Your feedback is greatly appreciated! The City of Corona seeks ongoing collaboration with the community in our effort to be better stewards of our local resources and build a more sustainable environment.

The objective of the project is to replace turf grass along parkways of Masters Drive with Water Friendly Landscape using one of the three landscape designs – Evergreen Carpet, Mediterranean Accent, and Rustic California. This effort is being implemented to meet the State's 20% by 2020 Water Conservation Plan, requiring a 20% reduction of urban water use by the year 2020. Additionally, implementing such landscaping will reduce maintenance and water costs.

The survey results revealed that most participants overwhelmingly prefer the Mediterranean Accent landscape design, followed by the Rustic California and the Evergreen Carpet. As such, the City will begin a proactive program to implement the Mediterranean Accent following the estimated project timeframes:

- **Late Spring 2012** Complete Landscape Design
- **June – August 2012** Project Bidding
- **Fall 2012** Construction
